
Nanoscale Research Facility Weekly Update - April 01



Subsidized Practice Time No fooling, not a joke!

Attention PIs and Users: Did you know the NRF offers an Extended Training session as subsidized (free to you) practice time on select tools? During these pre-scheduled sessions, staff will log a new user into the tool and assist with loading/preparing the practice sample. Research samples can NOT be used during these practice sessions. The user will then have some independent time to practice on the tool, perfecting their technique. These sessions are generally restricted to 8am-9am, which is historically a low use time in our facility, meaning staff is more likely to be available if/when questions arise. For users who feel the base training was too short, or didn't provide enough independent operation opportunity, these sessions will allow for some extra practice at no additional cost to the project. Still not really sure what stigmation is, or how to correct it? This is your chance to practice without running up the bill. If you want to ask about the availability of a practice session, we recommend you reach out to us via email.
