Safety Side Note

Be Sure to Properly Dispose of Your Hazardous Waste



Improper disposal of hazardous waste is an EPA and EH&S violation. Be sure you know what you are working with, where it needs to be disposed of, and ensure the waste containers have appropriate labels on them.

Never overfill waste containers. Liquids need head space in the bottles, so 2/3 full is full. Be especially aware when using funnels as bottles may fill quickly and are easily overfilled. Too little is much better than too much in waste containers. When in doubt make a new bottle.
