




Al Ogden, *Engineer*

After the military he studied Field Ecology in Texas and Central America, came to UF in 1982 to study Agronomy. He joined the Photonics Research Lab and affiliated private research lab Advanced Photonic Technologies at which point he built his first photolith area, deposition lab, clean room and post fabrication processing and testing lab. In the late '90s he moved to the Department of Physics and assisted with the construction, logistics of assembling of the test apparatus for the detectors used in the Compact Muon Solenoid for the LHC in CERN. He became General manager of the Microelectronics Lab at ECE which was later merged with other facilities that would evolve into the Research Service Center.
